Notes on March 26, Meeting of Black Faculty and Staff

Black Faculty and Staff agreed not to hold classes until President Fleming agrees to meet the BAM demands.

The group agreed to contribute to a strike fund which would aid any student who encounters trouble with the University or other Public authorities.

Any action against any Black student, staff, personnel, or faculty who participated in the strike activities would be considered an act against the

entire Black University Community.

The group agreed to take part in all student picketing and other activities related to the BAM Demands. Moreover, we are to be identified by badges specifying that Black Faculty and Staff support the strike.

Black alumni will be contacted in order to appraise them of the true situation and to solicit support to BAM in the form of financial contributions, and telegrams to the Board of Regents and the University. Black faculty and staff will communicate their support of BAM directly to the Regents.
